

Dr. Martin Enderle, Chief Executive Officer

As Chief Executive Officer (CEO), Dr. Martin Enderle is responsible for the strategic further development of the Scout24 Group as well as that of all the associated marketplaces, for the organisation and the integration. Beyond this, Martin Enderle is the spokesperson of the Group.

Dr. Martin Enderle was born in 1965. He studied mathematics at the University of Karlsruhe and King's College in London prior to earning a PhD at the University of Hannover. From 1995 to 1999, he worked for McKinsey & Company in Hamburg, specialising in the automotive and telecommunications industries.

In 1999, Dr. Martin Enderle moved to Munich where he proceeded to set up the German branch of the venture capital enterprise Speed Ventures. Over the next two years, Speed Ventures founded and funded around 30 Internet and technology businesses.

Dr. Martin Enderle joined T-Online in 2001, where he initially managed the international operations and investments of T-Online. He succeeded in fundamentally restructuring the latter in many European countries and leading them to profitability.

Being in charge of the M&A division of T-Online, he was the driving force behind the acquisition of Scout24 in the year 2004 and subsequently assumed a supervisory role with Scout24. In June 2005 Dr. Martin Enderle took over the management of Scout24 Holding GmbH, and he was Director of Immobilien Scout GmbH in Berlin from April 2008 till January 2010.
