

Marc A. Sevray, Chief Financial Officer

As Chief Financial Officer (CFO) Marc Sevray is in charge of all the financing and investment projects of the Scout24 Group. In his role as CFO he is responsible for all matters related to controlling, accounting, legal, corporate governance and risk management.

Marc Sevray was born in 1970. During his preparation for the accountancy exam, which he sat at the Normandy Business School in 1999, he was working for the company PwC Deutsche Revision as a Senior Audit Manager. From there he transferred to Allen & Overy, where he was employed as Finance Manager for Germany.

From 2001 to 2005, Sevray worked for T-Online International, initially as Senior Manager for International Business, and later as Senior Manager for Investment Analysis and Controlling. In this role he participated in the affiliation of T-Online and Deutsche Telekom in 2004, as well as the acquisition of the Scout24 group by Deutsche Telekom.

In 2005 Sevray transferred to T-Online France, where he occupied the position of Chief Financial Officer. Since September 2007 he is CFO of Scout24 Holding GmbH.
